AGE LIMITS

Under 11 Boys and Girls - 9 on the day of the race and under 11 on 1st September 2008

Ages as at 1st September 2008

Veteran Men 40-49, 50-59, Over 60 on the day of the race

Veteran Women 35-44, 45-54, Over 55 on the day of the race

TEAMS

Under 17/20 women will be a combined team competition using any combination of runners (3 to score).

Senior Men which will be 6 to score, Veteran Men 4 to score, all others 3 to score.

There is NO Under 20 Men team competition.

Under 20 and Veteran Men may score in a Senior Men's team.

Teams will be scored using the first required number of athletes 6/4/3 to finish, B teams etc would score the next 6/4/3 whatever number required for that age group.

Veteran Men and Veteran Women teams must be declared ONLY if a club has a SENIOR MEN'S or SENIOR WOMEN'S team.

ENTRY FEES

No team entry fees, enter as individuals. Entry fees : **U11 Boys and Girls £1.50, all others £3-00**

Cheques and Postal Orders made payable to NOTTINGHAMSHIRE AAA

All runners are to wear club/school, County, Area or International vests. Athletes wearing any other vest risk disqualification unless they have the Referee's permission.

QUALIFICATION runners must have been born in Nottinghamshire or, have been a resident for at least 9 months in the County prior to the day of the competition. Runners are ineligible if they have competed in another County Championships or represented another County in the Year of competition.

Selection for the County team will be based mainly on these Championships.

Senior Men and Women the first 6 + 3 at the selector's discretion (9 to run)

All other age groups the first 7 +1 at the selector's discretion (8 to run)
